<u>Declaring the Word of God – by Clay Howell</u>

What image comes to mind when you consider the phrase "the Word of God?" What does that phrase mean? I would bet that most of us who have grown up attending church conjure the mental image of a Bible. Whether you think of the NIV Bible you have on hand now, the King James version you memorized passages from as a child, or even scrolling the YouVersion Bible app on your phone, we correctly associate the Word of God with Scripture. I believe this is a good thought to have, and should be the starting point for this discussion. The written words of Scripture are the inspired Word of God. I also believe that this phrase has other meaning, which is pointed out in Scripture itself:

"1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made."

These words that begin the Gospel of John echo the words that begin the book of Genesis, reminding us that God has been King since the beginning of time. This passage emphasizes that Jesus is just as permanent, and just as legitimate, as God Himself. The words of Scripture tell us that Jesus Himself is "the Word of God." Why is Jesus described that way? How can a real, physical person be a Word?

In class the last few weeks with the Youth Group, I have been teaching a series called "Speak." We have explored what it means to listen to the voice of God, declare the Word of God out loud, and speak to one another with care and kindness. In this class, we have discussed that words are permanent. Once something is spoken out loud, it often can't be taken back. In the same way, Jesus is the ultimate declaration of who God is. Jesus is God, spoken out loud.

In turn, we have the opportunity as Christ-followers to be Jesus, spoken out loud. How can our words reflect the words of Jesus? How can we give voice to the written words of Scripture that our world so desperately needs to hear? Let us learn to be heralds of the Word of God as we declare the coming of His Kingdom.
